The St. Joseph County Parks & Recreation Commission is updating its 5-Year Parks & Recreation Master Plan for 2014-2018. We are soliciting input from the public to help develop goals and specific action items to pursue during this period.

The mission of the St. Joseph County Parks & Recreation Commission is to provide nature areas, boat and canoe launch sites, camp sites and well maintained recreational sites and facilities that will be useful and appealing to residents and visitors alike. The Commission was established in 1969 and seeks to develop large, natural resource-based regional parks that are typically the responsibility of county units of government.

St. Joseph County Parks & Recreation owns or leases and manages eight parks with approximately 415 acres of land. These parks are:

- 1. Cade Lake County Park & Campground; 97 acres; Fawn River Township
- 2. Hoshel Canoe Park; 9 acres; Lockport Township
- 3. Margaret Feek Recreation Area; 36 acres; Leonidas Township
- 4. Meyer Broadway Park; 160 acres; Fabius Township
- 5. Rawson's King Mill Park; 12 acres; Leonidas Township
- 6. Sweder Nature Preserve; 3 acres; Fabius Township
- 7. Timm County Park; 95 acres; Florence Township
- 8. Wahbememe Historical Monument; 1 acre; Mottville Township
