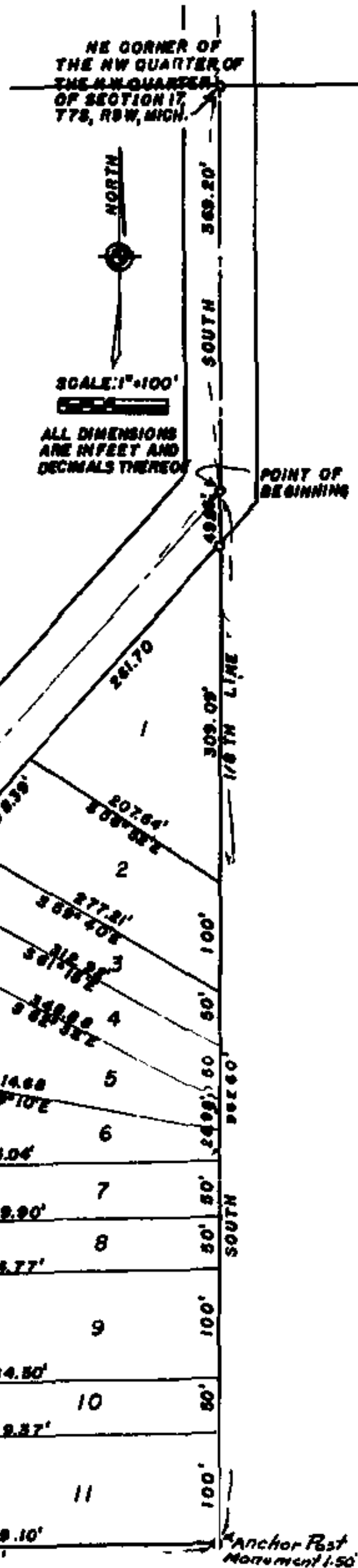

## DESCRIPTION

The description of Leister Perrin's Pleasant Valley Subdivision, a subdivision in the Northwest one quarter of section 17, Town 7 South, Range 9 West, Burr Oak Township, St. Joseph County, Michigan, is as follows: Beginning at the Northwest corner of the northwest one quarter of the northwest quarter of said section 17 and running thence South along the west one eighth line of said section 360.20 feet to the place of beginning; thence South along said eighth line 942.80 feet, thence South 80 degrees and 25 minutes east 533.78 feet to the center of a county road, thence North 41 degrees 28 minutes and 30 seconds along said road centerline 1290.88 feet to the point of beginning.
