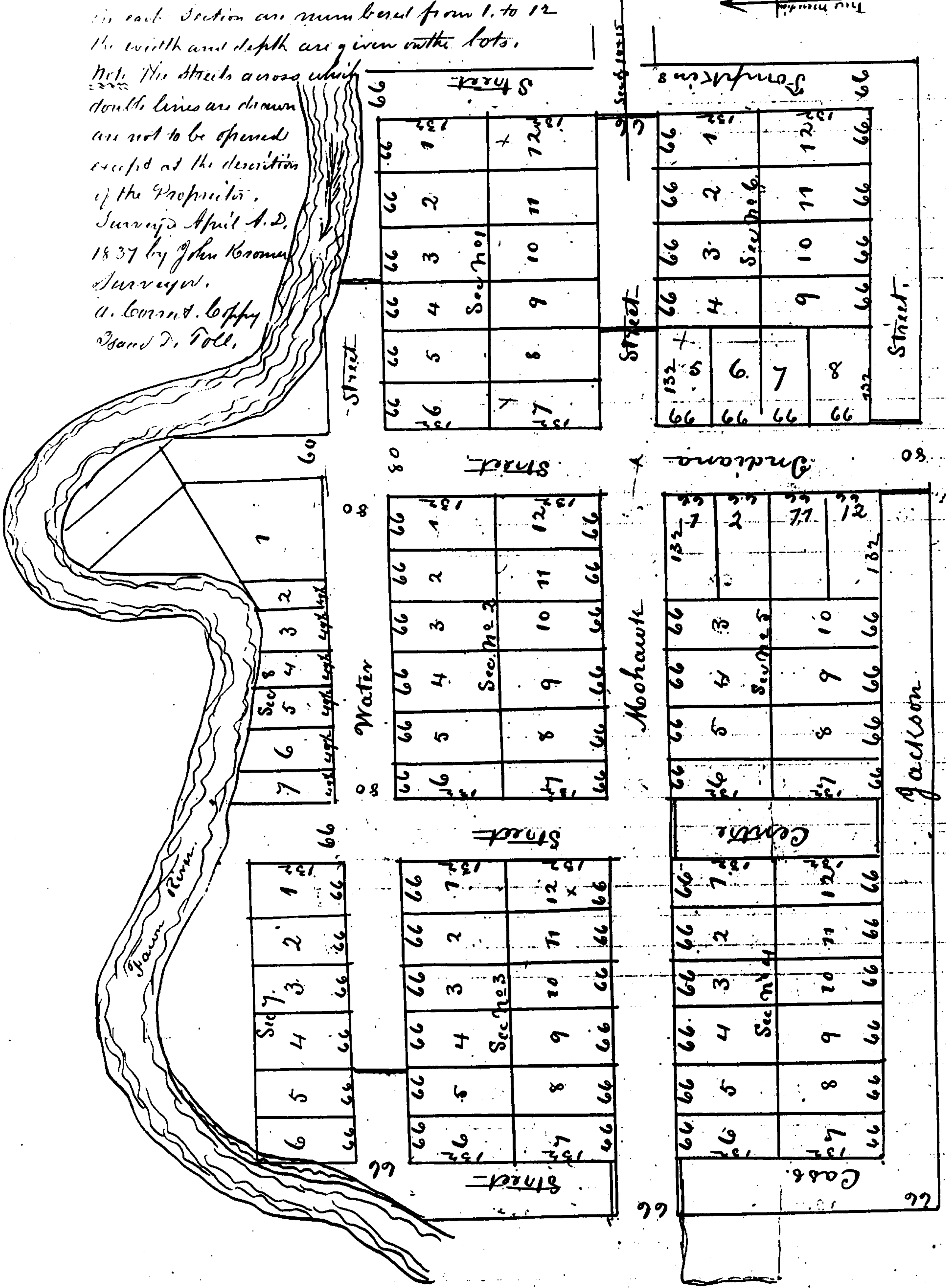
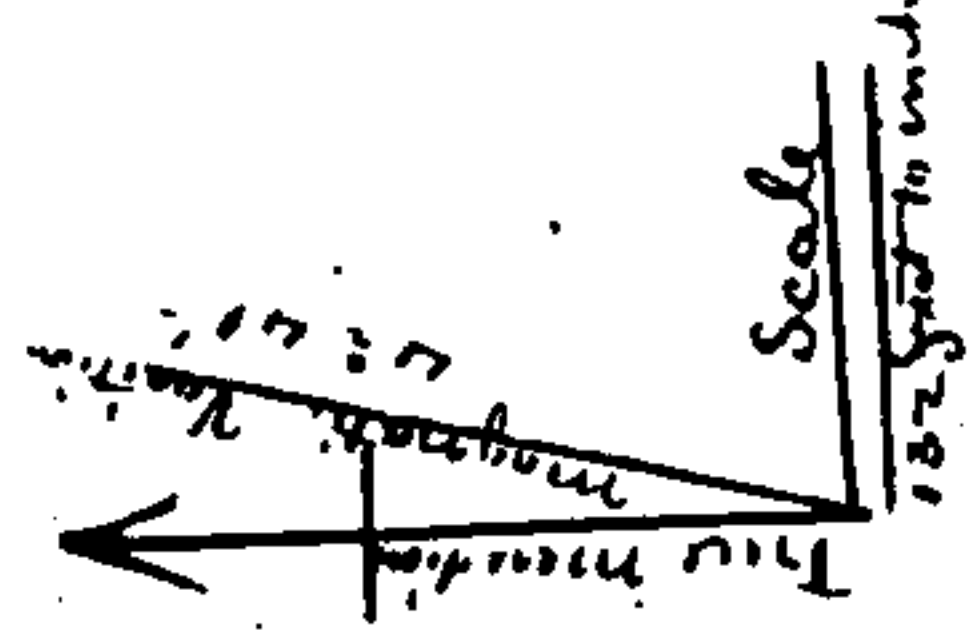


The Village of Hiram River.
