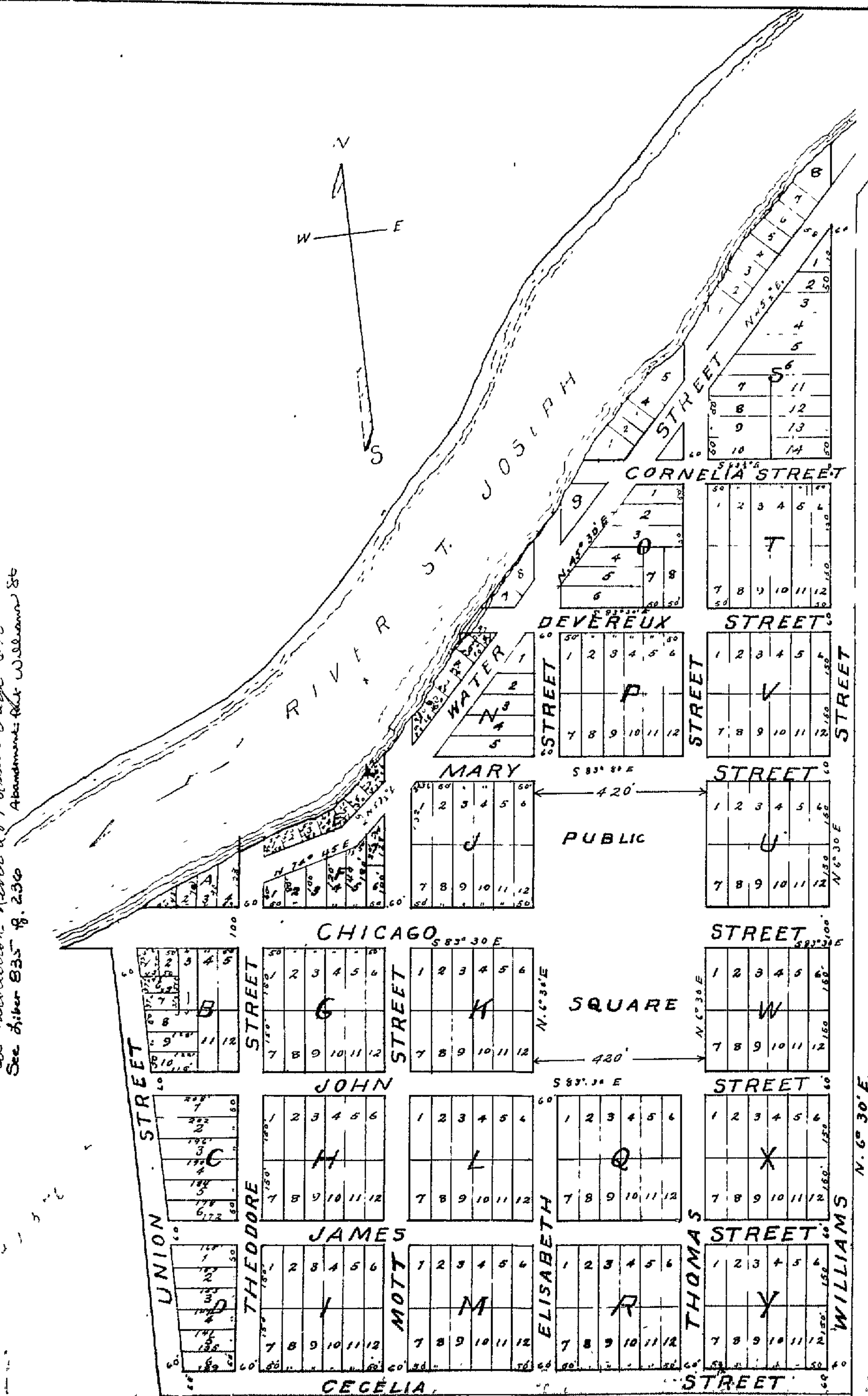
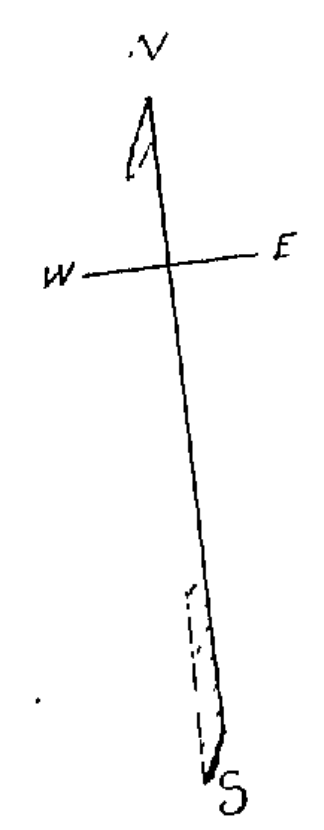

 COUNTY of ST. JOSEPH, TERRITORY of MICHIGAN.  
 by Orange Risdon, Surveyor.  
 May 31st, 1830.

Note The Public Square intended for public buildings Churches School houses &c four hundred and twenty feet in width and Eight Hundred and twenty feet in length  
 The Chicago Street is One Hundred feet wide and all the other streets except Water Street sixty feet wide Water Street is fifty eight feet wide.  
 The regular lots are fifty feet front by one Hundred and fifty in depth reserving therefrom in all the regular blocks ten feet from the rear of each lot for the purpose of opening thereon a regular Block an alley of twenty feet in width

Mottville Personally appeared before me John Winchell one of the Justices of the Peace for the County of St. Joseph within the territory of Michigan John R. Williams of the City of Detroit who exhibited to me the Town Plat to which this is annexed under the name of Mottville or in other words the same to me as described and for the purposes therein set forth and as evidence thereof consented to perpetuate the same, consents that it may be recorded agreeably to the provisions of the Statute entitled 'An act to provide for the recording of Town Plats and for other purposes
