

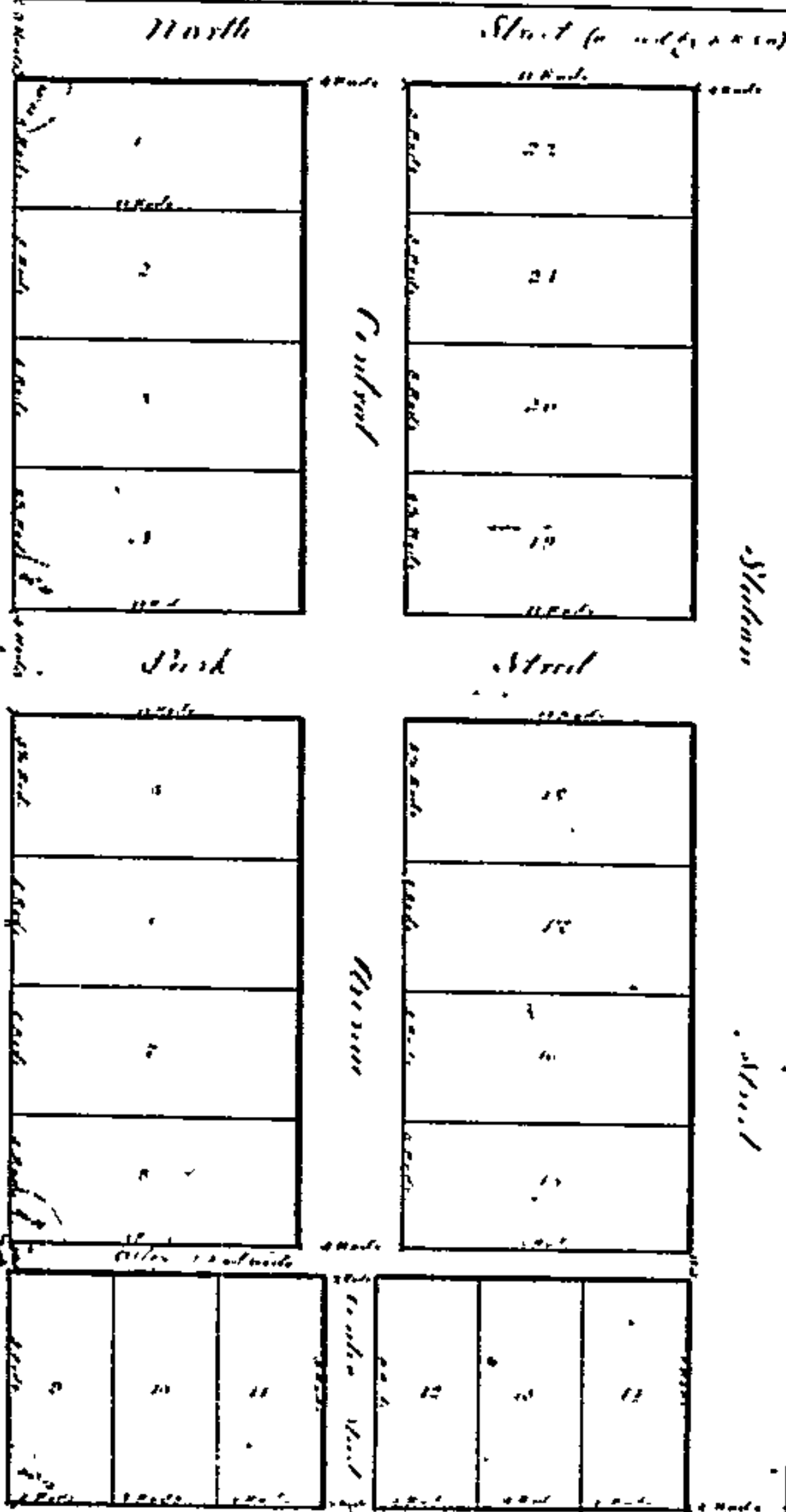
MAP OF MOORE PARK

Quarter of said Section 21st 27th or North along the Quarter line 57 rods thence East to parallel to the South line of said Section 32 rods thence South 57 rods thence West on the Section line 32 rods to place of beginning

The axes of all lots are as the figures upon the outer sides of the lots in the plat. The widths of Streets & alleys are as the figures on the Plat.
