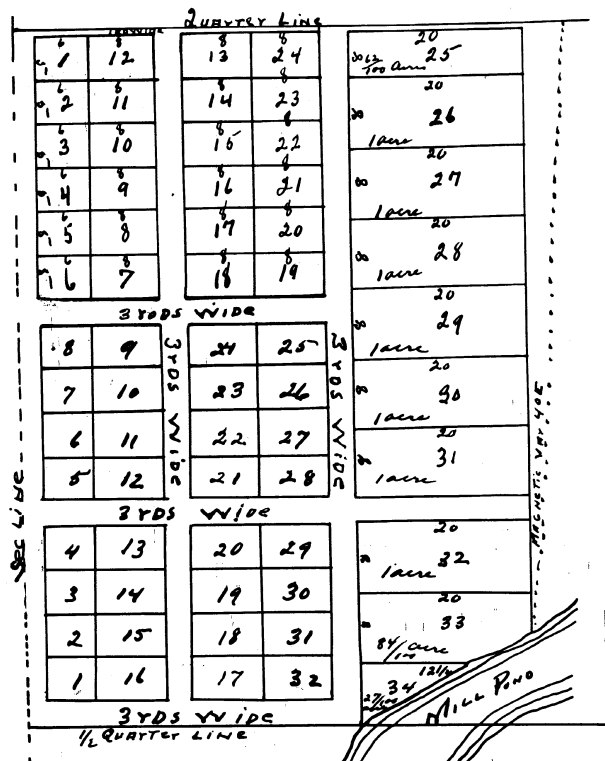


OSBOYNS ADDITION
