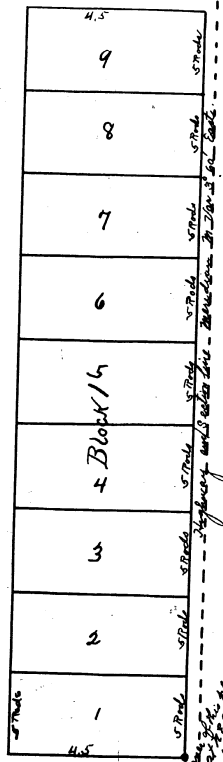


Perrin's Addition to the Village of Parkville
