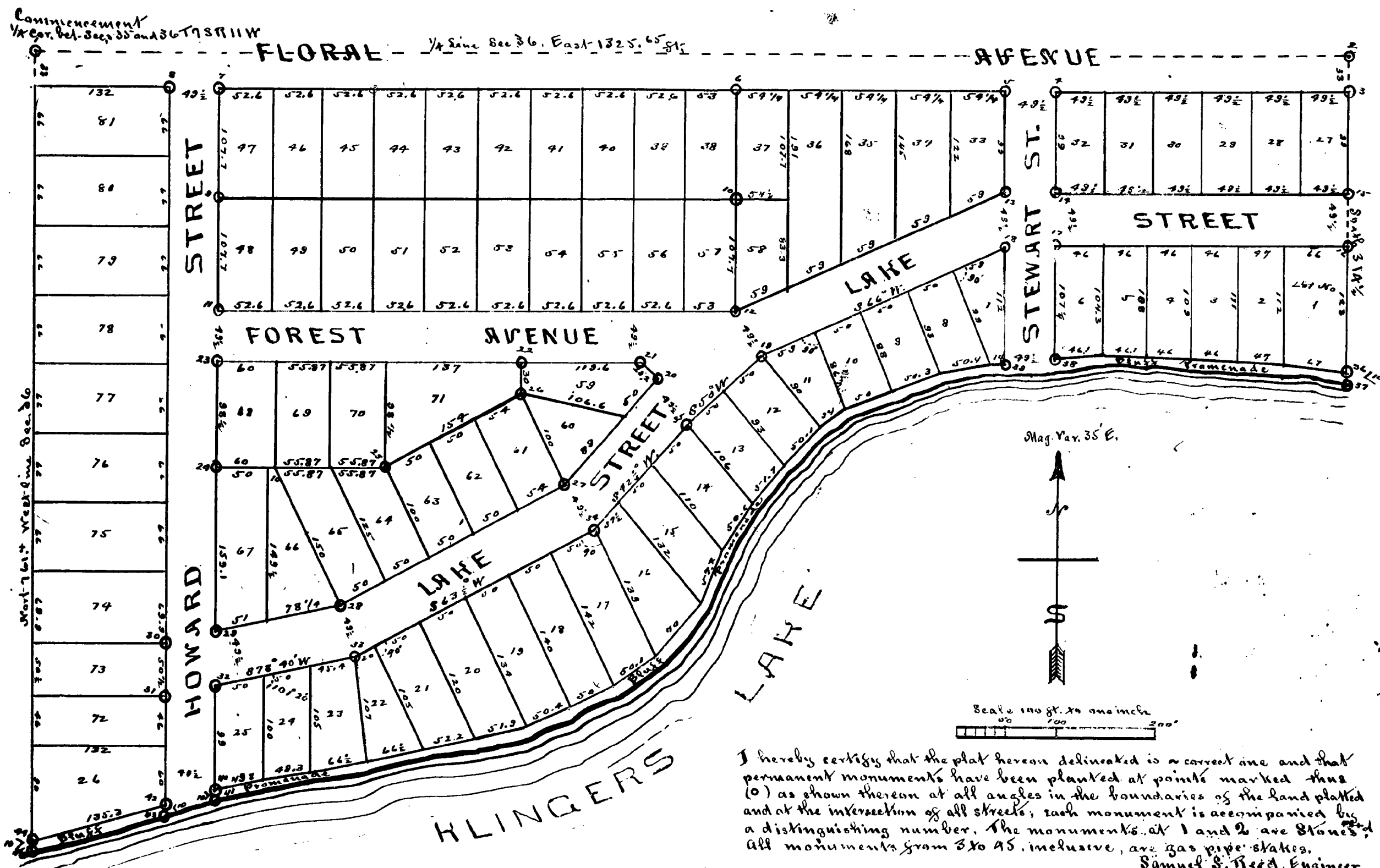

DESCRIPTION

A subdivision of the West 1/2 of the south-west fractional 1/4 of section No. 36 T. 7 S. R. 11 W., being in the County of St. Joseph and State of Michigan, bounded as follows, to-wit: beginning at the 1/4 section cor. between sections 35 and 36, T. 7 S. R. 11 W., thence east on 1/4 line 125.65 ft. to 1/2 corner, thence South 314.5 ft. to the margin of Hlingers Lake, thence West along the margin of Hlingers Lake to the west line of section 36 and thence north on the section line 761.4 ft. to place of beginning.
