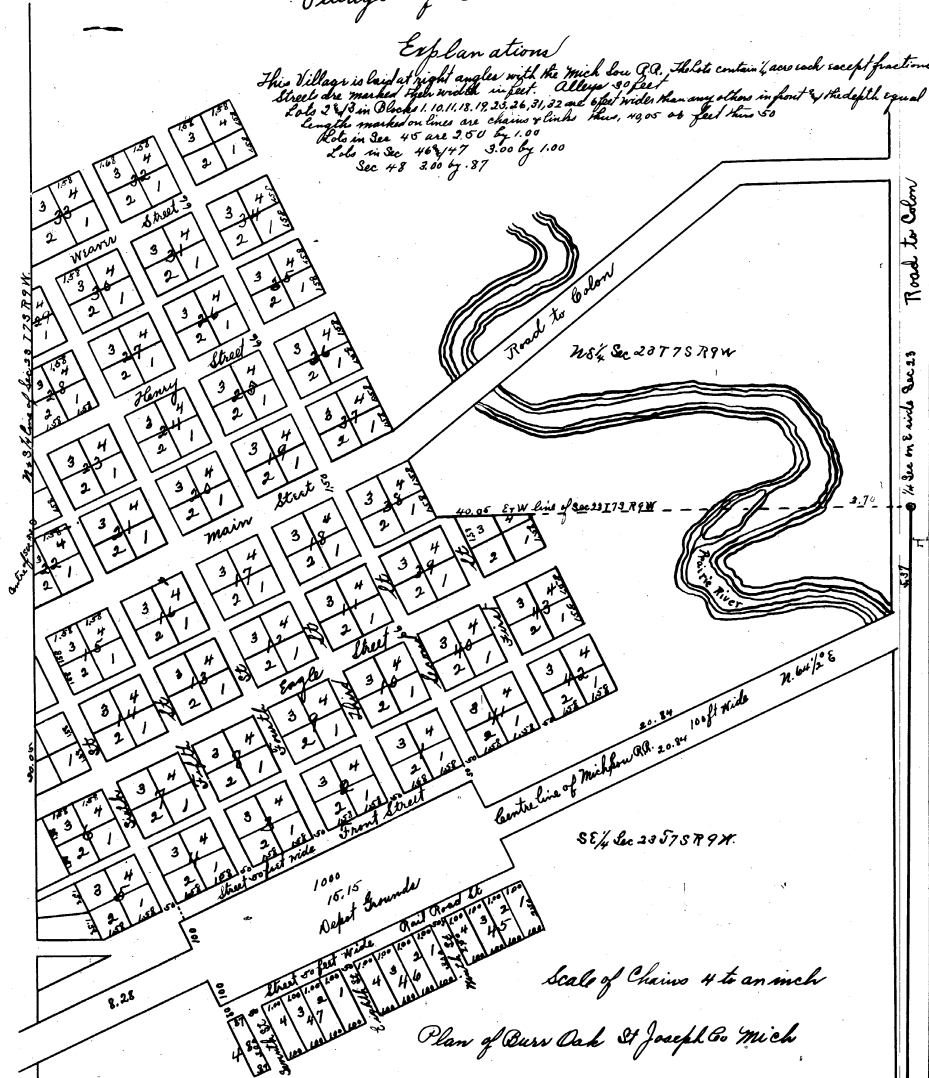


Village of Burr Oak

Explanations

This Village is laid at right angles with the Mich. Cen. RR. The lots contain 2 acres each except fractions
 Streets are marked with widths in feet. Alleys 8.0 feet
 Lots 3 & 4 on Blocks 1, 10, 11, 12, 13, 23, 24, 25, 22 and 60 ft wider than any others in front & 1/2 depth equal
 Lots marked on lines are chains & links. Thus, 19.05 is feet then 50
 Lots in Sec. 45 are 250 by 1.00
 Lots in Sec. 46 & 47 3.00 by 1.00
 Sec 48 2.00 by .87
