


Village of Burr Oak

Explanations

This Village is laid at right angles with the Mich. Line RR. Lots contain 6 acres each except fractional lots. Lots are marked with width in feet. Alleys 30 feet wide. Lots 2 & 3 in Blocks 1, 10, 11, 18, 19, 23, 26, 31, 32 and others wider than any others in front & back of equal length marked on lines are chains & links there, 1905 as first time 50.

Lots in Sec 45 are 350 by 100
Lots in Sec 46 & 47 300 by 100
Sec 48 300 by 87

Know all men by these Presents that we William Lock and Henry Kearn of Burr Oak in the County of St Joseph and State of Michigan proprietors of the within plat of the Village of Burr Oak in said County (William Lock being the proprietor of that part of said plat lying south of the quarter line and Henry Kearn being the proprietor of that part of said plat lying North of said quarter line) do hereby give and grant all the Streets and alleys laid out in said Village plat to the public for the use of the public for public highways, agreeable to the Statute in such case made and provided.
