


R.A. Vails Addition to the Village of Burr Oak

Know all men by these presents that I, Richard A. Vail of Burr Oak, in the County of St. Joseph & State of Michigan proprietor of the within Plat of R.A. Vails Addition to the Village of Burr Oak, in said County do hereby give & grant, all the Streets, alleys laid out in said Village Plat to the public for the use of the public for public highways, agreeable to the Statute in such case made and provided. In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 27<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty five.
