**Notes of Explanation**  
 Schellhaus and Thorns addition to the village of Constantine is located on the southern part of the North East fractional quarter of Section Number 23 (23) in Township Seven (7) South of Range Twelve (12) West Meridian of Michigan. The size of all regular lots is placed upon the sides and ends of one or more lots in each Block. The larger figures in the Blocks represent the numbers of the Blocks and the smaller figures in the center of the lots denote the number of the lots. The figures on the ends and sides of lots represent their length and width in chains and decimal of a chain. Spring Street is two (2) rods wide all other streets are four rods wide.
