1. All regular lots are 10 rods or 165 feet deep and 5 rods or 82 1/2 feet front.
2. All streets are 4 rods or 66 feet wide Alleys are all one rod or 16 1/2 feet wide.
3. No ground is intended to be given to the Public for alleys on each side.
4. All Distances are given in feet unless otherwise expressed.
5. That part of the Plat which is printed has been laid out and recorded heretofore viz Sections 8, 9, 13 & the North halves of 16 & 17.
