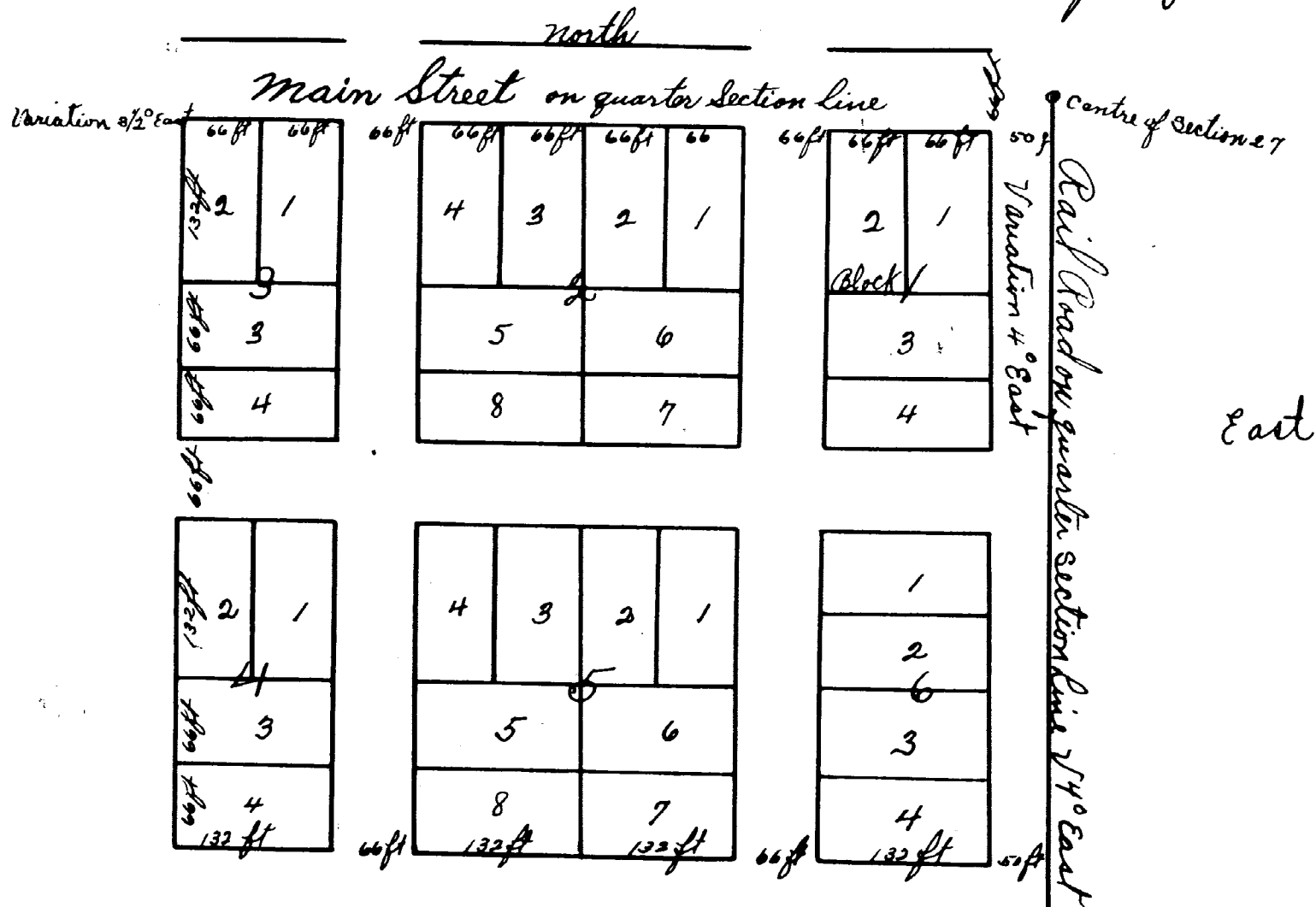


Custards Addition to the Village of Mendon



Plat of Custards addition to the Village of Mendon County of St Joseph Michigan being on the North East quarter of the South West quarter of Section twenty seven (27) Township five (5) South of Range ten (10) West lots are sixty six (66) feet front by one hundred and thirty two (132) feet in length Streets are sixty six (66) feet wide, surveyed April 12th 1866 by J. H. Gardner, Co. Surveyor

The North and South streets are parallel with the North and South quarter section line, and the East + West street with the East and West quarter section line

Know all men by these presents, that J. Wesley P. Custard of the township of Mendon County of St Joseph and State of Michigan, Proprietor of the above Plat entitled "Custards Addition to the Village of Mendon" the same being owned by me and located on the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec 27 in Town 5 South of Range 10 West and I do hereby give and grant all streets laid out in said Plat to the Public for the use of the Public agreeable to the statute in such case made and provided.
