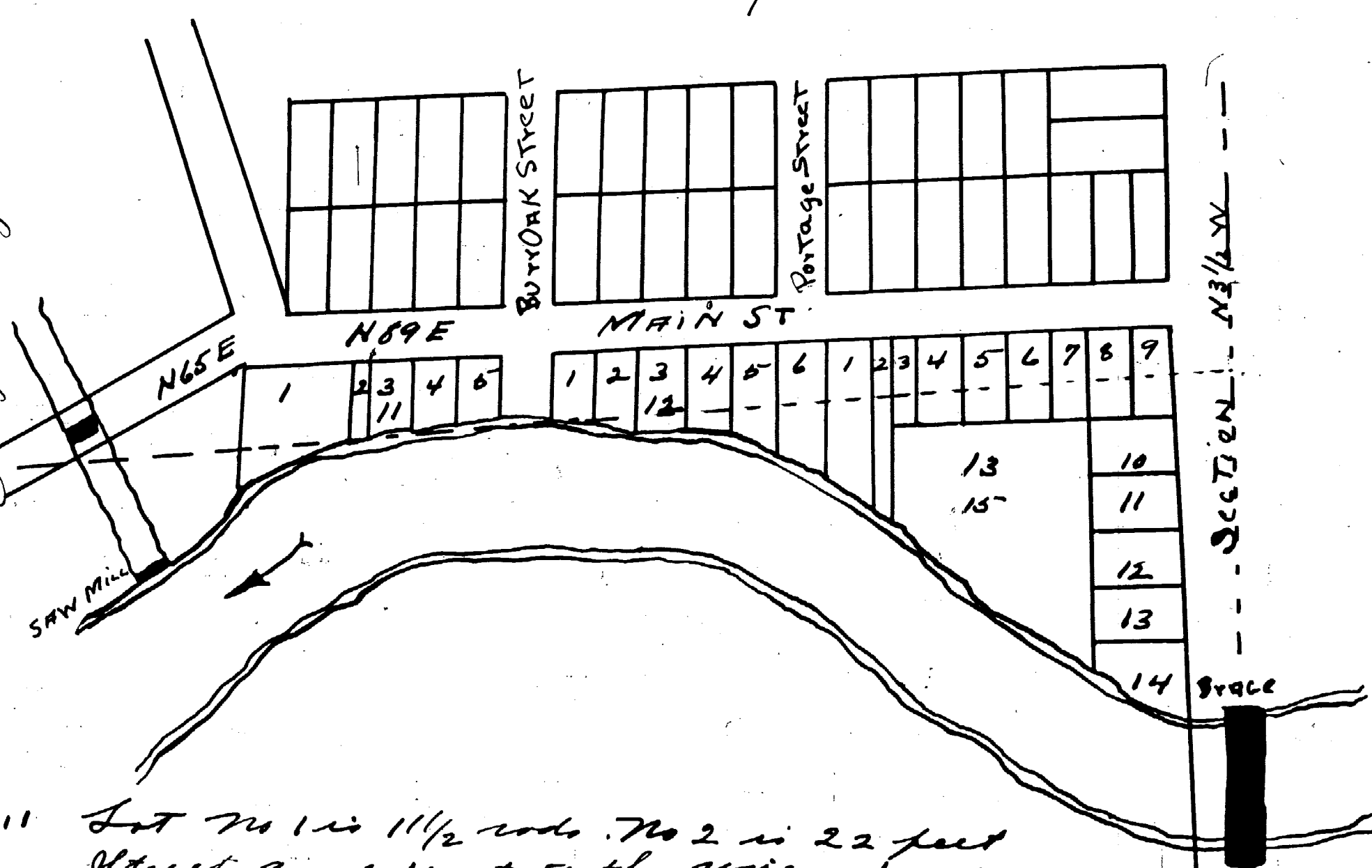


Metty's Second Addition to the Village of Mendon

BLOCK No 12 Lots 4 rods on main street and run to the river
BLOCK No 13 Lot No 1 is 4 rods on main street & No 2 is 24 feet and both run to the River No 3 is 42 feet by 8 rods All other full lots are 4 rods by 8 except except lot no. 15 which lies south of lots No 3, 4, 5, 6, & 7 running to the river bed on section twenty seven Town 5 south R 10 W.
