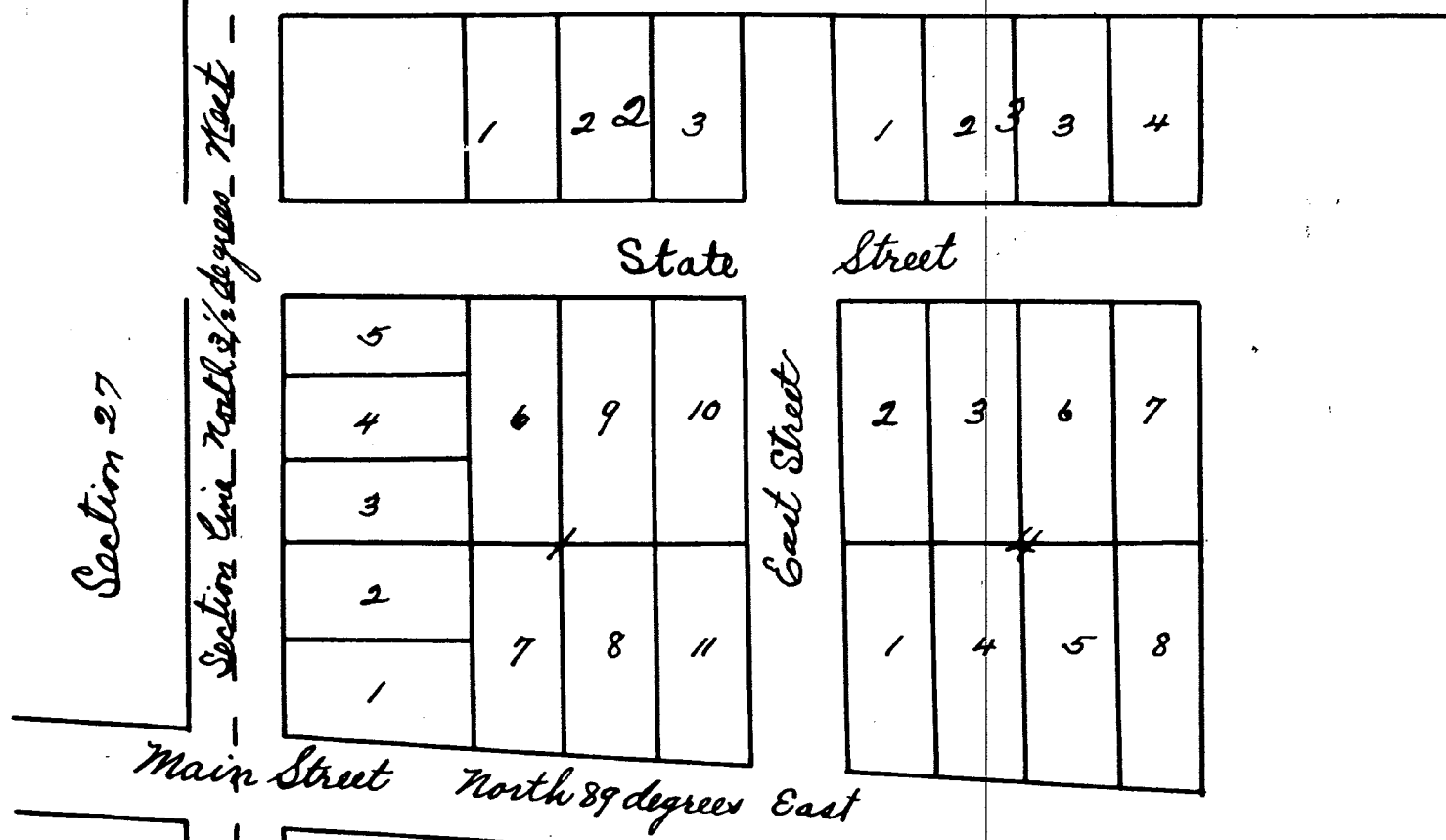


Oliver S. Norton's Addition to the Village of Mendon

Survey and Plat of Oliver S. Norton's Addition to the Village of Mendon in the Town of Mendon County of St Joseph and State of Michigan located on the North West quarter of Section 26 Township Five (5) South of Range Ten (10) West

The South West corner of Lot No. One in Block one is 3 1/2 rods North of the 1/4 post one quarter line and 2 rods East see plat and Explanation The courses of Streets and lanes as the Magnetic needle now points. Magnetic Variation 3° 40' West

Explanation

Lot No. 1 Block one is fractional 8 rods long 4 3/4 wide at the West end Lots No. 2, 3, 4, 5 on Block one, and Lots No. 1, 2, 3 in Block 2, and Lots No. 1, 2, 3, 4 in Block 3 are 4 by 8 rods. Lots No. 6, 7, 10 in Block one, Lots No. 2, 3, 6, 7 in Block 4 are 4 by 11 rods Lots No. 7, 8, 11 in Block one and Lots 1, 4, 5, 8 in Block 4 are fractional being 4 rods wide and from 9 1/2 to 11 1/4 rods long see plat The Streets are all 4 rods wide
