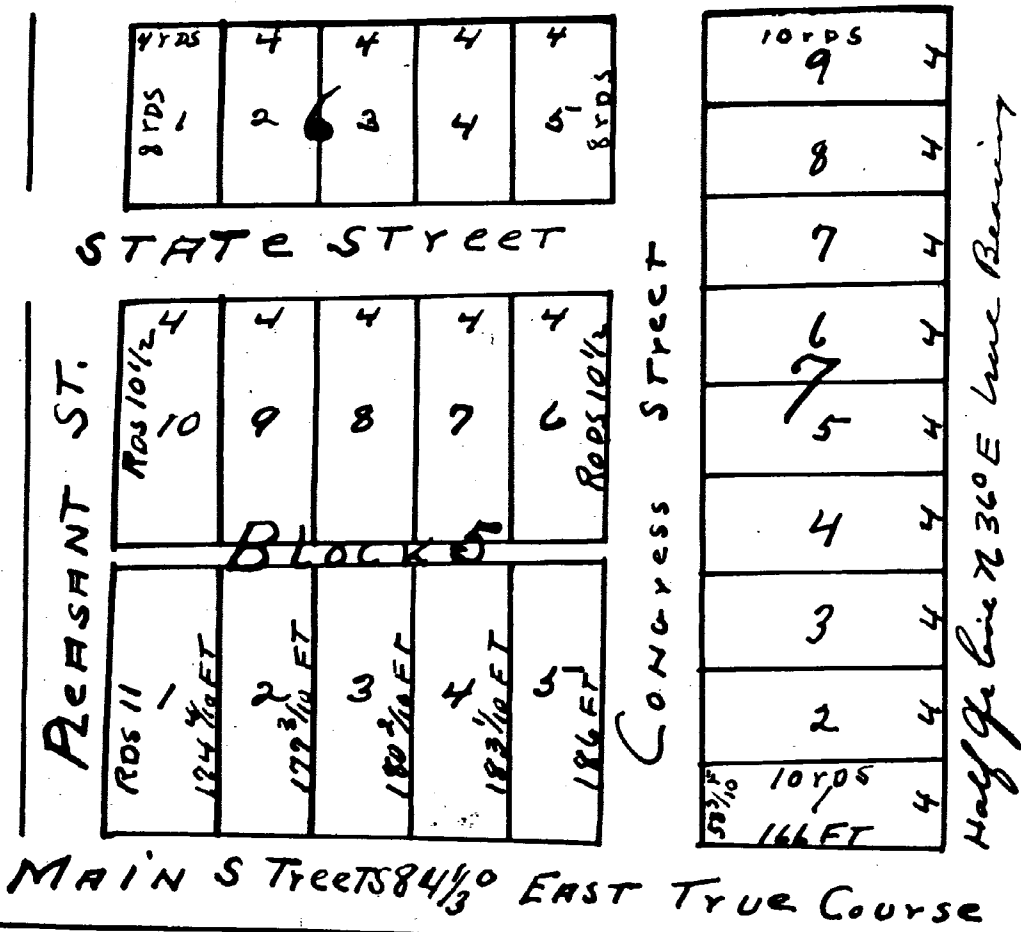


O.S. NORTON'S

Survey and Plat of Oliver S Norton's East Addition to the Village
of Mendon County of St Joseph Michigan located on the north west quarter
of sec. 26 Township five south of Range 10 west. The north west corner of
lot no. 1 in Blk 6 is 120 rods south & 46 rods east of the north west
corner of the section. Variation of the meridian is 3° 10' E Surveyed Oct 8. 1866

Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, & 5 in Blk 6 are 4 by 8 rods. Lots 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, & 9 in Blk 7
are 4 by 10 rods. Lots 6, 7, 8, 9 & 10 in Blk 5 are 4 by 10 1/2 rods. All lots along
main street are for and the dimensions are marked on them.
Streets are four rods wide. Alleys are rod wide.

I know all men by their present that I Oliver S Norton of
Mendon Mich. the proprietor of the accompanying Plat entitled Norton
East addition to the Village of Mendon do hereby give and grant all
the streets and alleys laid out in said Plat to the Public for Public
highways agreeable to the Statute in such case made and
provided. Witness my hand & seal this 27th day of September A.D. 1870
