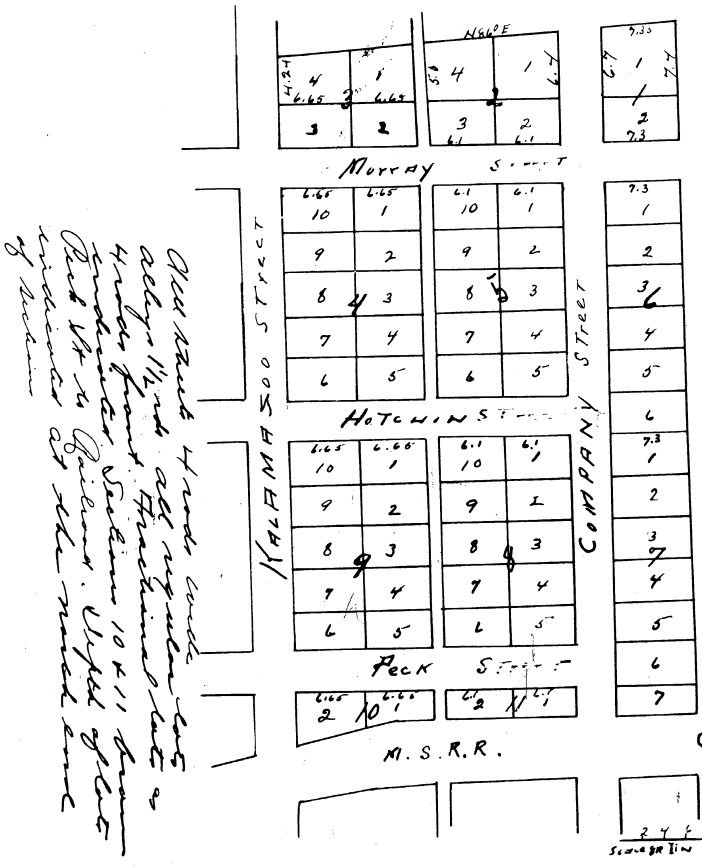

I know all men by their presents that we Samuel C. Laird John Murray
and John Hatcher of the Township of White Pigeon St Joseph Co. and State
of Michigan proprietors of the village Plat called Laird Murray and Hatcher
addition to the village of White Pigeon the same being owned
by us and located between the village of White Pigeon and
the Michigan Southern railroad and adjoining to and extending
partly east of the Range line between ranges no 8
and twelve in section 6 and 7 in Township no. 8 South
of Range no 11 west in the aforesaid Township of White
Pigeon and that we have good right to grant and do
hereby give and assign all the street and alley
laid out in said Plat to the Public for the use of the Public
agreeable to the Statute in such case made & provided I am
witness whereof we have hereunto set our hand and seals
this 3rd day of May A. D. 1865. } to the Reg
