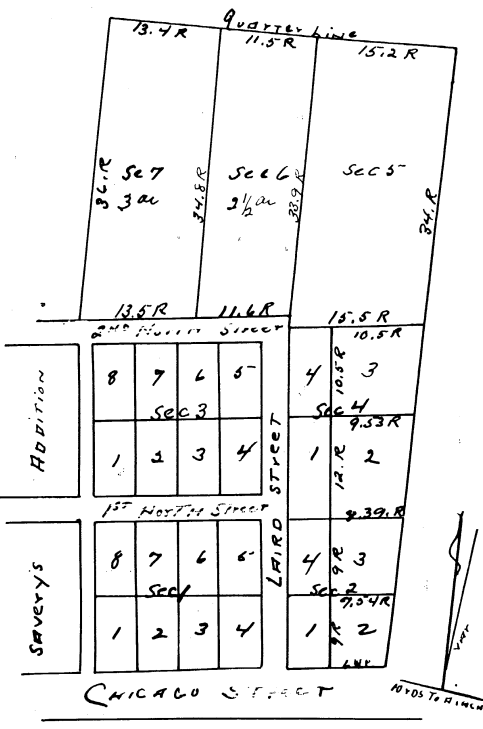


LAIRD'S ADDITION

**DESCRIPTION** Lots in Section No 1 and 3 are 5 by 9 rods. Lots No 1 and 4 in  
 section No 2 are 5 by 9 rods. Lot No 1 in Section No 4 is 5 by 12 rods. Lot No 4  
 in Section No 4 is 5 by 10 1/2 rods. Lots No 2 & 3 in section 2 and lots No 2  
 and 3 in Section No 4 and sections No. 5, 6 and 7 are as indicated in  
 Plat. Chicago Street is 100 ft wide and all other streets wide 30 ft.

I know all given by these presents that I Samuel C Laird of the  
 County of White Pigeon St Joseph Co. and State of Michigan proprietor of the  
 within Plat entitled Laird's Addition to the Village of White Pigeon the  
 same being owned by me and located east and adjoining to  
 Savery's Addition to the Village of White Pigeon and between Chicago  
 Street and the East and West Quarter line of Section 6 upon east half  
 of the south west Quarter of Section Number (6) in Township No (8) South  
 of Range (1) west in the aforesaid Township of White Pigeon and  
 that I have good right to grant and do hereby give and grant  
 all the street and alleys laid out in said Plat to the Public  
 for the use of the Public agreeable to the Statute in such case
