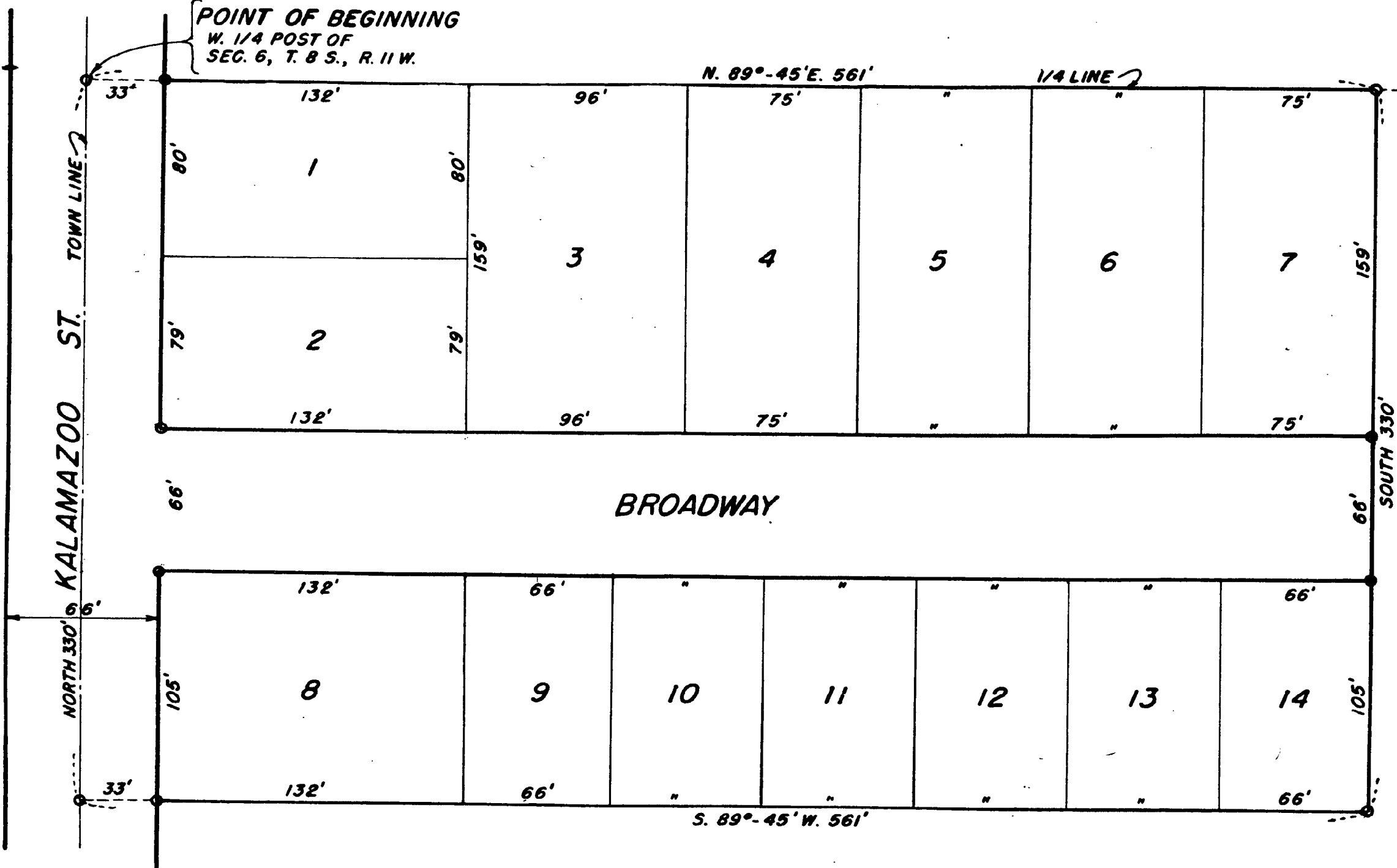


MC FALL ADDITION

DESCRIPTION:

The description of McFall Addition to the Village of White Pigeon in the northwest fractional quarter of the southwest fractional quarter of Section 6, Town 8 South, Range 11 West, White Pigeon Township, St. Joseph County, Michigan, is as follows: Beginning at the west quarter post of said Section 6, in the center of Kalamazoo Street, and running thence north 89 degrees 45 minutes east along the east and west quarter line 561 feet, thence south 330 feet, thence south 89 degrees 45 minutes west 561 feet to the west section line of said Section 6, thence north 330 feet to Beginning.

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE:
