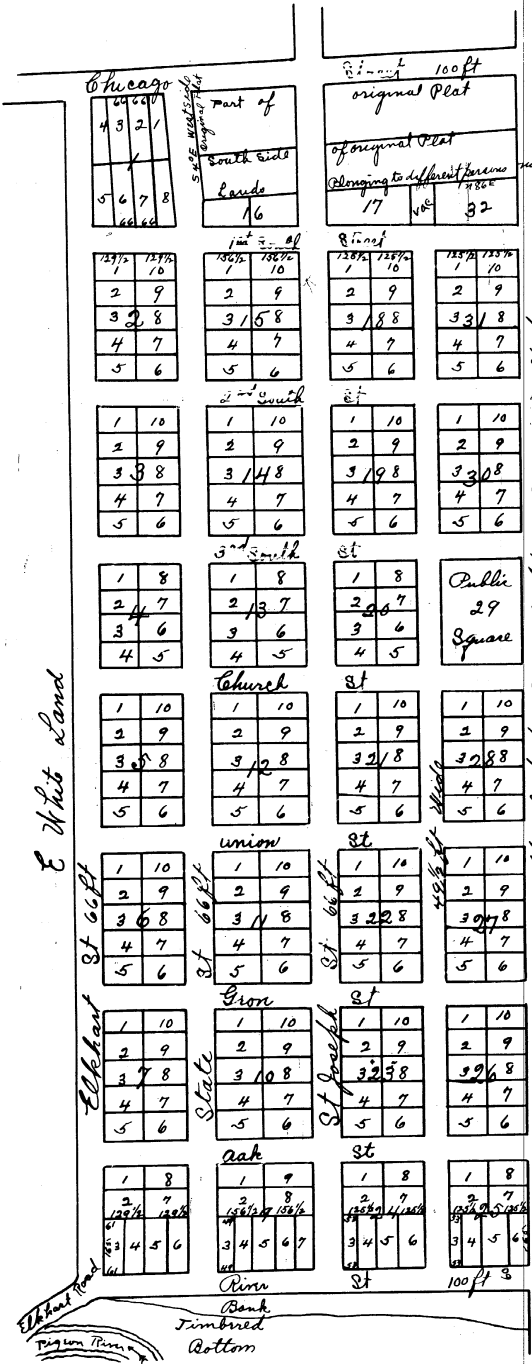


Mc Goffry, Chapin & Kellogg's Addition to Pigeon.
