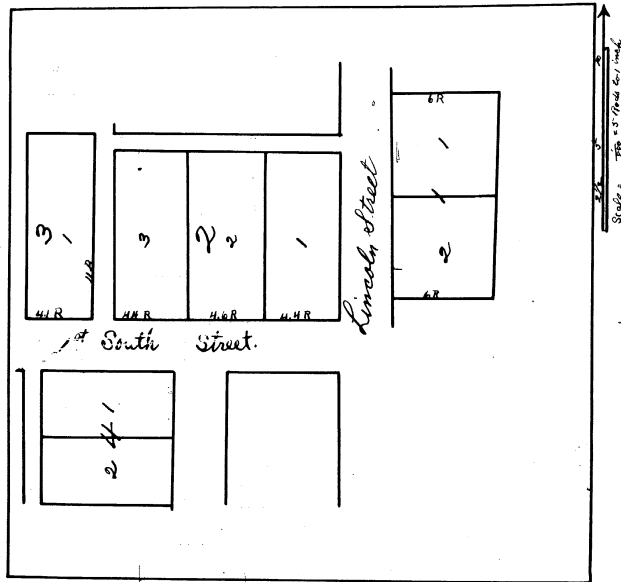


Newkirk's Addition to the Village of White Pigeon



Explanation.

On Block number one Lots one and two are Six Rods by Six Rods square. On Block number two Lots n<sup>o</sup> One Two and Three are respectively four and four tenths - four and six tenths and four and four tenths rods by ten Rods. On Block number Three Lot one is four and one tenth rods by Eleven Rods. In Block number Four Lots n<sup>o</sup> One and two are four rods by eight rods. First South Street is Three rods wide and all alleys one rod wide. Lincoln St is three rods wide. The West line of Lot n<sup>o</sup> One in Block n<sup>o</sup> Three and the Alley West of Block n<sup>o</sup> four are forty rods East of Walamazoo St as per Plat Village White Pigeon

Know all men by these presents that I Cornelius C. Newkirk of the township of White Pigeon St Joseph County State of Michigan Proprietor of the within Plat entitled "Newkirk's Addition to White Pigeon" the same being owned by me and located upon the South West fractional quarter of Section number Six (6) in Township number Eight (8) South of Range number Eleven (11) West in the aforesaid township of White Pigeon and that I have good right to grant and do hereby give and grant all the Streets and alleys laid out in said Plat to the Public for the use of the Public agreeably to the Statute in such case made and provided.
