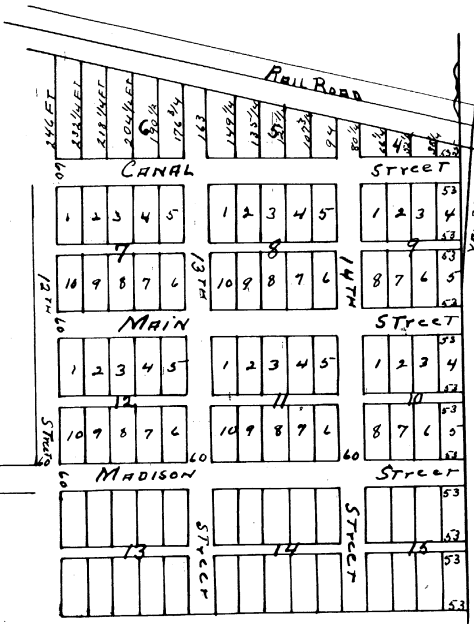


C. P. BUCKS ADDITION
