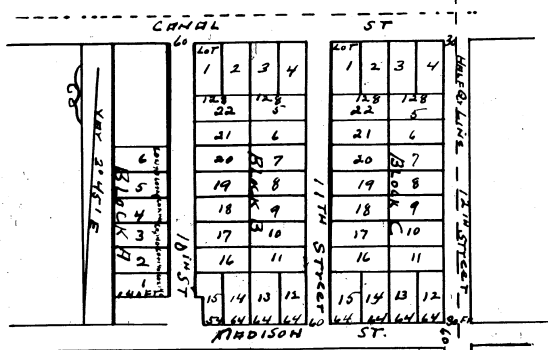


A. B. CLARK'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF THREE RIVERS
