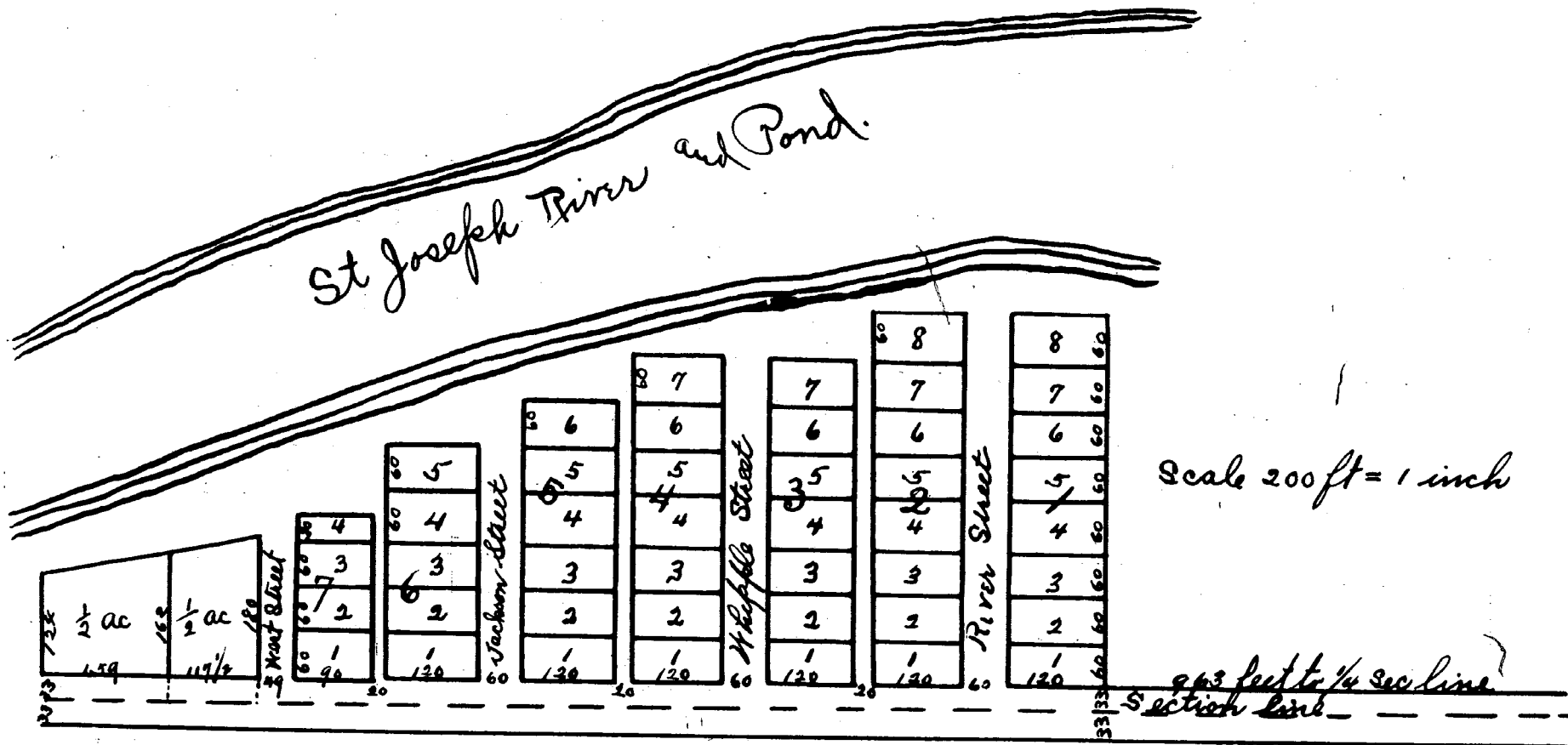


Jackson and Whipple's Addition
