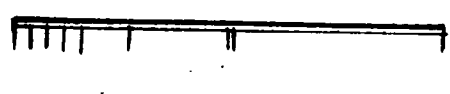

East half of Section 19, West 9/16 of North-West 9/16 & West 9/16 of South-West 9/16 of sec 20, Township 6 South of Range Eleven West -

All Blocks except Fractional Blocks are 300 feet square. All Lots fronting North and South on Public Squares and Broadway are 42 1/2 feet. All Water Lots are 60 feet front except those in Blocks 39, 40 and 60, which are 42 1/2 feet front. The size of all Fractional Lots are taken ascertained by Measurement, as per scale of this Map.

Mill Race, 100 feet wide to station 21, from thence to the end of Race 60 feet wide. Sidacurets Race 60 feet wide.

Franklin Square 300 by 420 feet. All streets are 60 feet wide, except Broadway, which is 82 1/2 feet wide.

All Alleys are 20 feet wide.

Franklin Square, and Streets and Alleys are given to the Village of Lockport.

All streets except Water Street, are laid out on a Meridian and cross each other at Right angles.

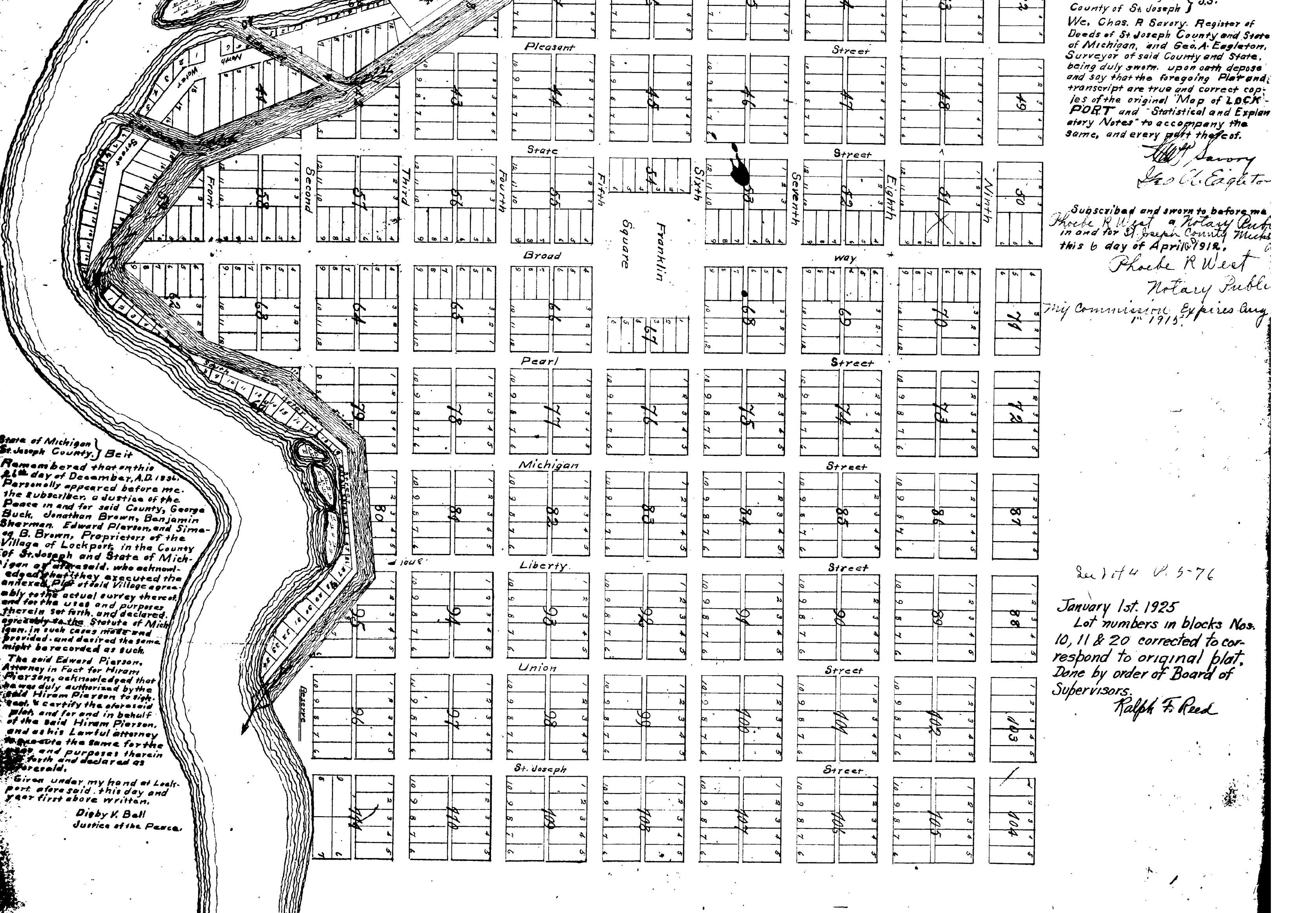

The said Edward Pierson, Attorney in Fact for Hiram Pierson, acknowledged that he was duly authorized by the said Hiram Pierson to sign, seal, & certify the annexed plat, and for and in behalf of the said Hiram Pierson, and as his lawful attorney, to execute the same for the uses and purposes therein set forth, and declared as aforesaid.
