Description of Land Platted.

Beginning 35.3 feet East and 33 feet South of the N. W. corner of the E. 1/2 of the 1/4 N. W. 1/4 of Sec. 19, T. 6. S. R. 11 W. St. Joseph Co. Mich. running thence S. 2° 20' W. 218.37 feet to North line of Swartz's Addition to Three Rivers, thence East 326.31 feet to the West line of King's Resubdivision and Addition to Three Rivers, thence N. 1° 42' E. 951.04 feet to a gas-pipe in West line of above Addition, thence N. 4° 54' E. 328.16 feet to the N. W. corner of lot "1" in the above Addition, thence East 125 feet to the West line of Constantine Street, thence N. 4° 54' E. 302.2 feet to the South line of Millard Street, thence N. 89° 45' W. 519.75 feet to place of beginning.
