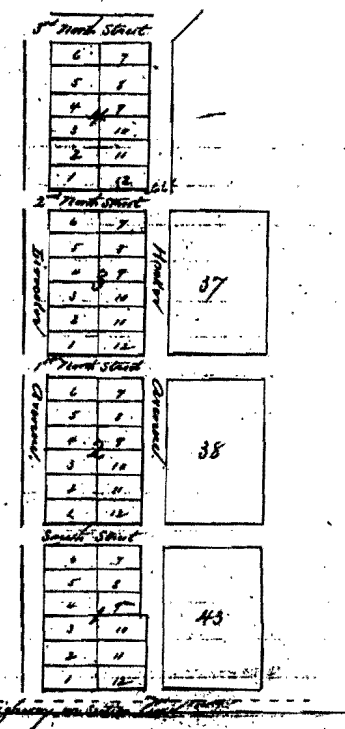

All Lots are four rods wide by eight rods in length, except Lots 10, 11 & 12 in Block No. 1, which are 9 rods and 4 1/2 feet in length. Hooker Avenue is four rods wide, except in front of Lots 10, 11 & 12 in Block No. 1, being there 45 feet wide. Several Avenues and all Streets are four rods wide.



Know all men by these presents, that I Henry Yeaumey of the Town of Lechport, in the County of St. Joseph and State of Michigan, Proprietor of a above Plat, entitled "Yeaumey's Addition to the Village of Three Rivers", the same owned by me and located West of and adjoining of Blocks 37, 38 & 43 in the original village of Three Rivers, & bounded on the South by the South line of Section 18, in the 6th Range of Range 11 West, & being a part of the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said Section, and do give and grant all streets and Avenues laid out in said plat to the Public for the use of the Public, agreeable to the Statute in such case made and provided.
