DESCRIPTION OF LAND PLATTED

The land embraced in the annexed plat of "Cliff Heights Addition No. 1" to the City of Sturgis, St. Joseph County, Michigan, is described as follows: Beginning at a point 14.89.08 feet South of the Northeast corner of section 12 township 8 south, range 10 west of the meridian of Michigan, thence North 89 degrees 40 minutes West 1323.75 feet along the South side of Cliff Heights Addition, thence South 0 degrees 34 minutes East 107.0 feet thence South 89 degrees 40 minutes East 1323.33 feet to the East side of said section 12, thence North 107.0 feet along the East side of said section to place of beginning.


