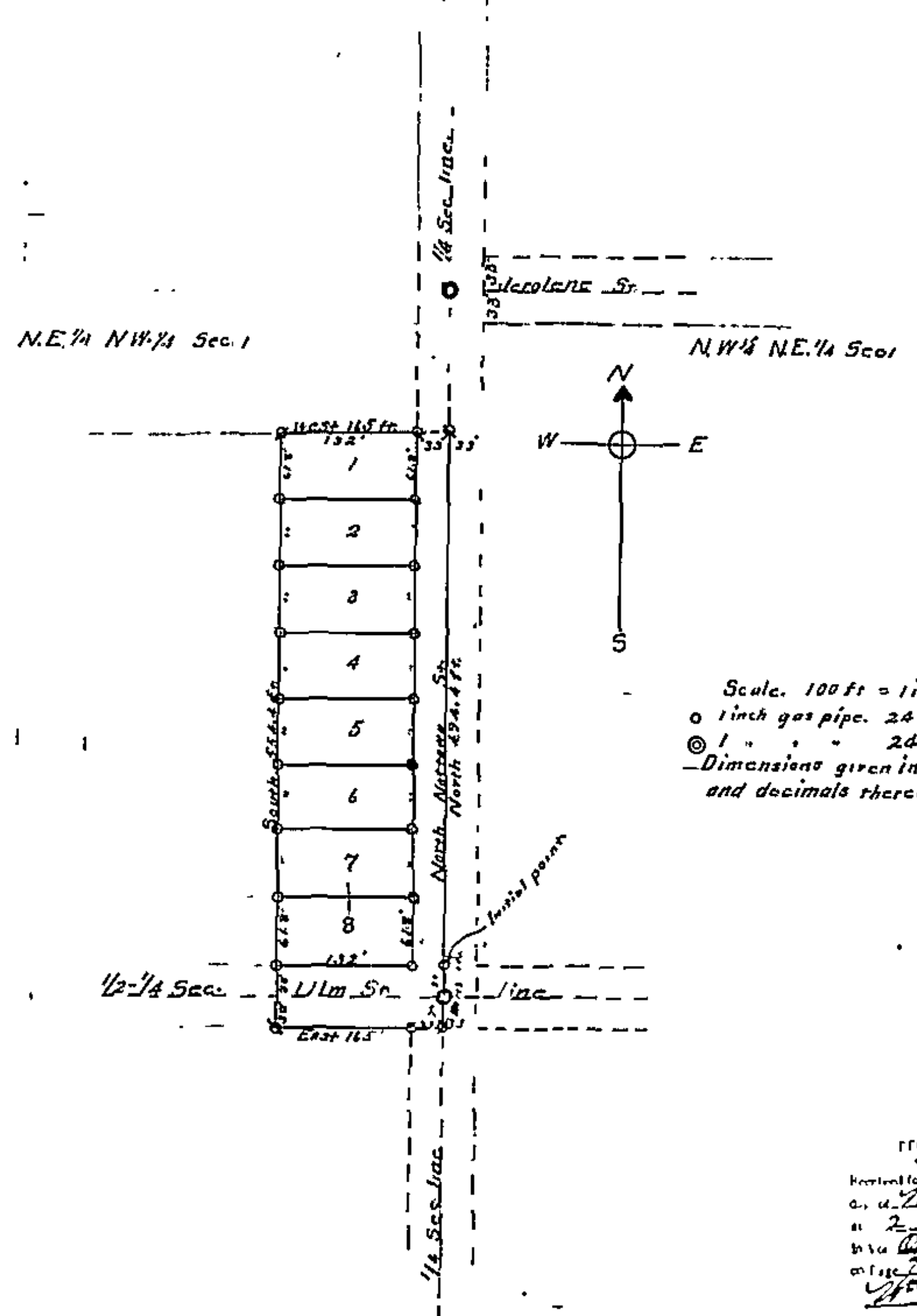

PLAT OF Elizabeth Cole's First Addition

TO THE City of Sturgis, St. Joseph County, Michigan

DESCRIPTION OF LAND PLATTED

Elizabeth Cole's First Addition to the City of Sturgis, Michigan, is located on the following described lands: Beginning 30 feet north of the southeast corner of the north-east quarter of the northwest quarter of section one, in township eight south of Range ten west, and running thence north four hundred ninety-four and four tenths (494.40) feet, thence west one hundred sixty-five (165) feet, thence south five hundred and four tenths (504.40) feet, thence east one hundred sixty five (165) to the place of beginning.
