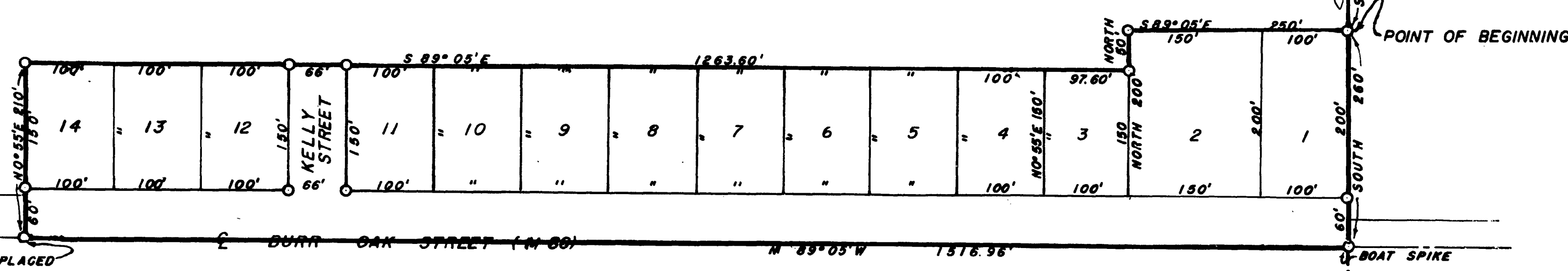
KELLYS' ADDITION

DESCRIPTION

The description of Kellys' Addition to the Village of Centreville in the Northwest one quarter of Section 25, Town 6 South, Range II West, Lockport Township, St. Joseph County, Michigan, is as follows: Commencing at a point on the North and South one quarter line of said Section 25 1012.10 feet South of the North one quarter corner of said Section 25 which is the place of beginning; the boundary runs thence South 260 feet to the centerline of Burr Oak Street (State Highway M-86), thence North 89 degrees and five minutes West along said street centerline 1516.96 feet, thence North 0 degrees 55 minutes East 210 feet, thence South 89 degrees 05 minutes East 1263.60 feet, thence North 50 feet, thence South 89 degrees 05 minutes East 250 feet to the place of beginning.

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE
