#### **Overview**

#### **Strategic Highlights**

The Road Commission continuously looks for opportunities to improve and create efficiencies. Going forward the focus will continue to be on working with our Township partners and the County Commission to improve the roads and bridges in St Joseph County.

#### **Financial Highlights**

The Michigan Transportation Fund (MTF) is the primary source of funding for the Road Commission. While the Michigan Legislature implemented a much-needed increase to the MTF beginning in 2017, the increase still falls short of the necessary funding to adequately maintain our 1,017.88 miles of roadway and 100 bridges. The most current concern is that inflation is diminishing the number of miles of roads we can improve every year with this funding. Despite these shortfalls, the Road Commission utilized available funding to make a positive impact on the transportation system within St. Joseph County. We also received an EGLE Rubberized Chip Seal Grant for \$290,385.

#### **Operating Highlights**

Our crews successfully took on the challenge of installing the Shimmel Road culvert measuring 99' long, 21' wide, and 14' tall. Doing this project inhouse saved taxpayers \$255,000. 2022 saw more than 44 miles of new road surface completed. This is the 3<sup>rd</sup> largest year ever for road reconstruction and resurfacing. Building a highly efficient and knowledgeable employee base has assisted SJCRC in these endeavors.

#### **Looking Ahead**

Over the next several years, the Road Commission and its partners will need to continue working together to decide the future of the road system within St. Joseph County. The needs of the road system far outweigh the funding received for roads within our County. As partners we need to determine the correct course of action into the future.

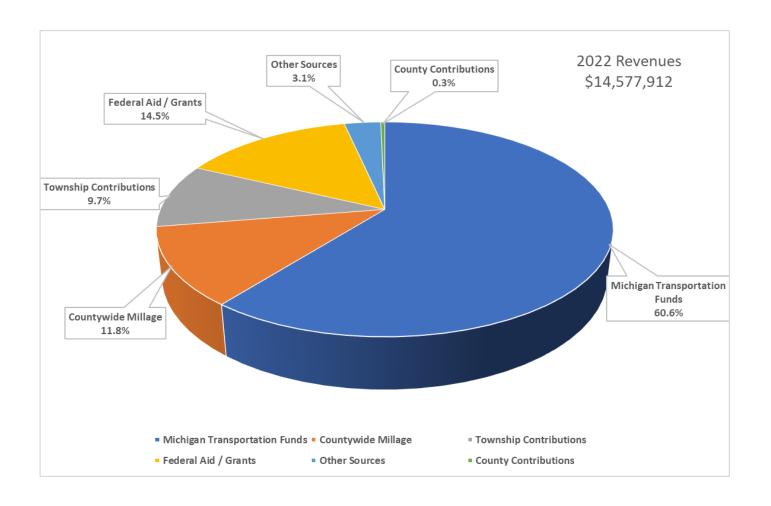

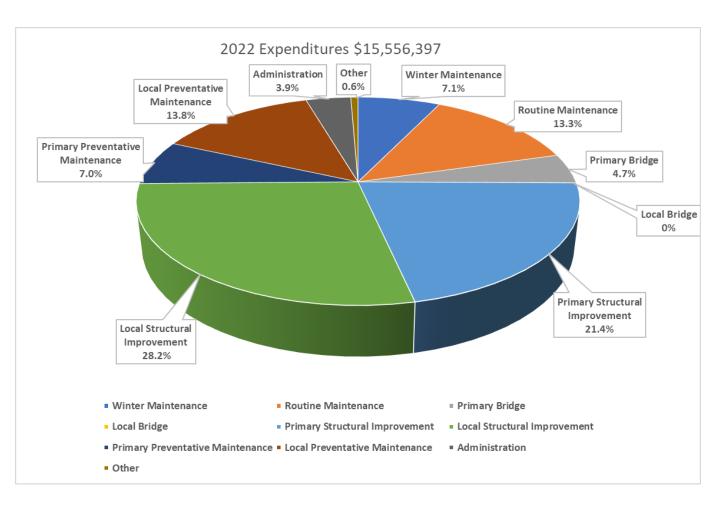

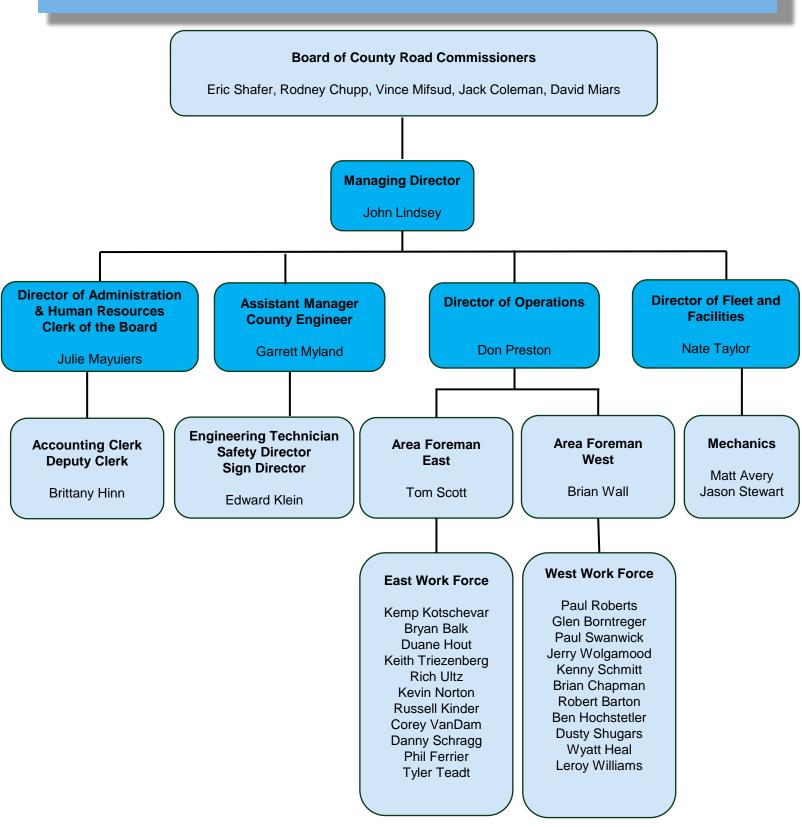
