Cade Lake Park Campground Rules

1. PAYMENT IS DUE IN FULL AT TIME OF RESERVATION

- 2. Do not set up camper/tent or occupy a campsite until reservation is confirmed and fees are paid.
- 3. Camping fees are non-refundable.
- 4. Occupancy limited to immediate family or up to four persons.
- 5. Not more than one RV/trailer and one tent, or two tents and no trailer will be permitted per campsite. All campers must be **backed** into the assigned campsite.
- 6. No "recreational unit" (RV/trailer) may be placed on Camping Cabin Site. One tent is allowed.
- 7. Camping permits may be issued for no more than 14 consecutive days. Permits may be renewed after the required separation period. **After 14 days, patrons must vacate the campground for a minimum of 48 hours.**
- 8. Anyone over the age of 18 must have a valid state issued photo ID to visit or camp. Anyone under the age of 18 shall be accompanied by an adult.
- 9. Check in time is 3:00 pm. Check out time 1:00 pm.
- 10. Camping permits must be renewed on or before the initial expiration date, subject to availability. Failure to renew permit prior to expiration will result in removal of site contents at the owner's expense.
- 11. Quiet time is 10:00 pm 7:00 am. All visitors must leave by 10:00 pm. The camp host is available for **EMERGENCIES ONLY** after 6:00 pm.
- 12. Alcoholic beverages are permitted at registered campsites only.
- 13. Fires are permitted in fire pits only. Collecting firewood from park grounds is not permitted.
- 14. Fireworks are prohibited.
- 15. Campsites shall not be left unoccupied for more than 48 hours.
- 16. One vehicle per site. Additional vehicles and guest vehicles must be parked in the day-use parking area.
- 17. Pets must be on a leash no more than 6-feet long. No pet shall be left unattended at any time. No pets are allowed on or near the beach. No pets are allowed in the cabin. Owners must clean up after pets immediately.
- 18. Waste-water lines must be fastened securely to sewer connection according to State health regulations.
- 19. Private watercraft may not be utilized until they have been sanitized and dried to remove invasive aquatic species. Gas powered motors are prohibited.
- 20. No person shall engage in any violent, abusive, boisterous, loud, illegal, obscene, or similar disorderly conduct that interferes with another person's use or enjoyment of the park. Radios, generators, loud exhaust, or any other device that creates excessive noise is prohibited.
- 21. CHOOSING TO VIOLATE ANY ST. JOSEPH COUNTY PARKS OR CAMPGROUND RULES WILL RESULT IN EVICTION AND/OR PROSECUTION.
