Seasonal Camping Fees & Policies

Camping Season: The first Friday of May through the Sunday prior to Columbus Day in October.

Application: Cade Lake County Park & Campground offers campsites that can be rented on a seasonal or long-term basis. Applications must be received by April 1. A deposit of \$250.00 must be submitted with your application. Your *deposit* must be made with a *personal check*. Applications will not be accepted without a deposit. Applications must be delivered to St. Joseph County Parks, 612 E. Main St., Centreville, MI 49032.

Payment: The fee is \$2,300.00/season (includes a one-time electricity fee of \$250.00). Payments must be made with a personal check, money order, cash, or credit card. *There will be no refunds*.

For seasonal campers, the seasonal fee must be paid on the due date. If it is not, the electrical pedestal will be turned off and locked and a charge of \$30.00 per day will be charged until it is paid, up to 7 days, or \$210.00. The additional charges will be due with the regular seasonal fee. If the fees are not paid in full by the end of the 7th day proceeding the due date, the camper will be towed at the owner's expense. The patron(s) will not be allowed on Cade Lake County Park property until the fees are paid in full. NO EXCEPTIONS.

SEASONAL CAMPING POLICIES

- 1. Seasonal camping fees are for 1 or 2 adults, and their minor children. No sub-leasing permitted.
- 2. All guests must leave the park by 10:00 p.m.
- 3. Registered children must be under 18 years old, or unmarried and living at home. Registered children 18 years old or older must provide identification with an address.
- 4. All seasonal campers will be charged a one-time electricity fee of \$250.00.
- 5. Seasonal campers will be provided with up to two (2) car passes at no charge. Additional car passes can be purchased for \$20.00. You must show proof that vehicles are registered to the Primary or Secondary Contact, or licensed child listed on the application. Only one vehicle is permitted at your campsite.
- 6. Vandalism, destruction, or misconduct of any kind by seasonal campers or their guests will result in immediate eviction from the campground with NO REFUND.
- 7. No tents are allowed on seasonal sites at any time without permission from the Director.
- 8. All other campground rules apply to seasonal campers and their guests.
- 9. Campground employees will not accept or forward any telephone messages or mail for seasonal campers, nor provide use of the campground telephone, unless there is an emergency.
- 10. No children under the age of 18 may be left at the campground without adult supervision.
- 11. Pets must be leashed and under control at all times. Pet waste must be cleaned up <u>immediately</u>. Pets presenting a threat to anyone or causing a nuisance will not be tolerated. Problems with your pet will result in eviction from the campground.
- 12. No physical changes can be made to any part of your campsite. No storage sheds, decks, landscaping, trimming, etc. are permitted. All property must be kept at least two feet away from roadways and adjacent campsites. Contact campground personnel if you have any concerns regarding your campsite.
- 13. Outdoor refrigerators or large propane tanks (over 40 lbs.) are not permitted.
- 14. Golf carts must be registered in the campground office, and a golf-cart fee of \$100.00/year is required. Proof of insurance must be provided. Golf carts may not be operated by unlicensed, unregistered persons at any time. Golf carts may only be operated on paved or gravel roads.
- 15. Campsites must be maintained in a clean and attractive condition. Contact campground personnel if you have questions or need assistance.
- 16. Regular maintenance, including mowing, string trimming, etc., is performed by park staff Monday and Tuesday. Please respect our time by ensuring your site's grass area is free of items and debris. **WE WILL NOT MOVE YOUR ITEMS.** If we have to move your items, you will be assessed a fee of \$50. Any equipment damaged (mowers, string trimmers, etc.) due to items (dog tie-outs, furniture, rugs, etc.) not being removed will be charged to you. If it becomes a regular occurrence, you will be evicted from the park.
