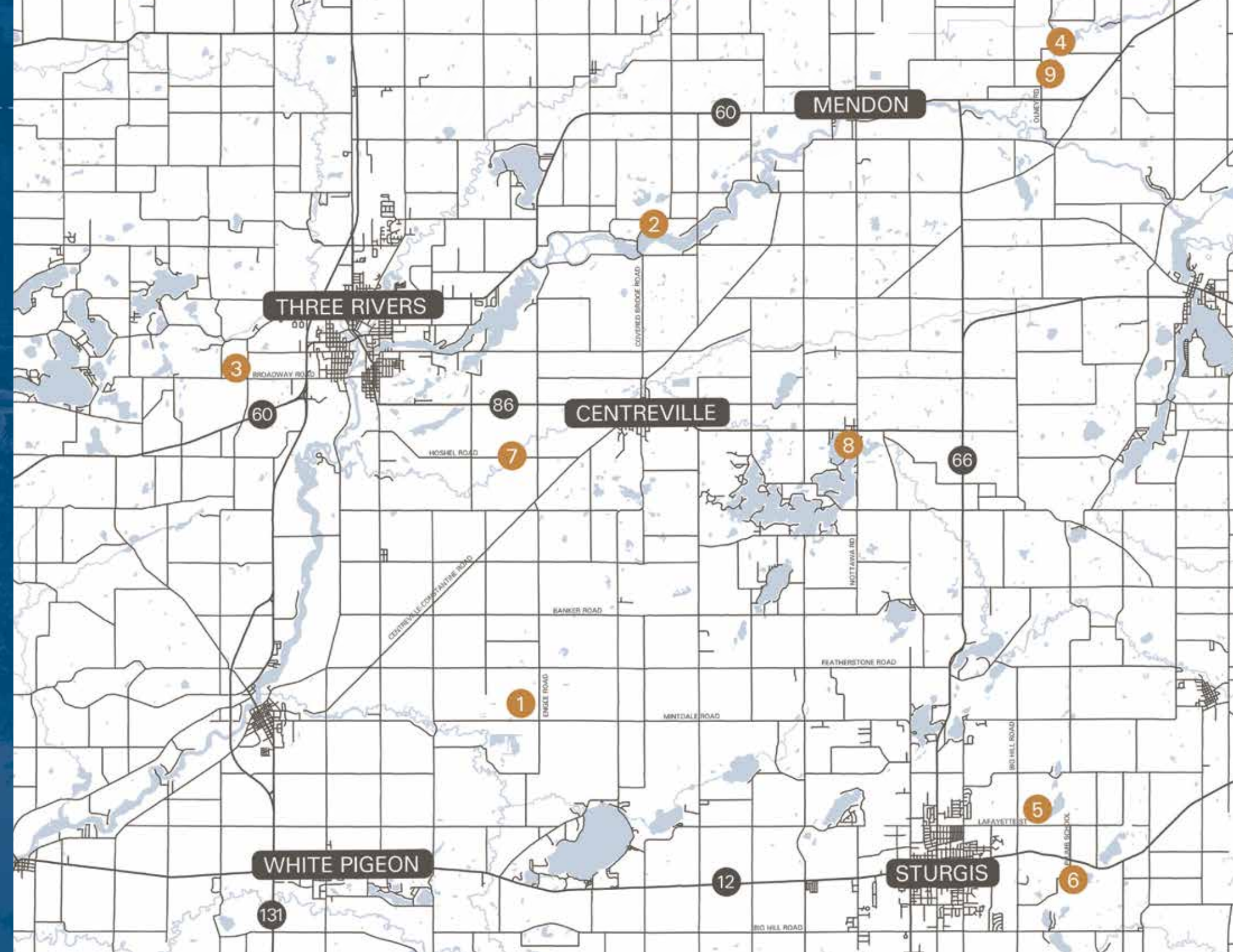
ACCESSIBILITY
