 and east of Romine's mill.

OBSERVATIONS - VILLAGE lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, are 33 feet wide and 109 feet deep lot no  
 34 is 99 feet by 123 ft all other lots except those on the north of said village are  
 49 1/2 feet front + 123 1/2 feet deep except lots no. 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, are  
 49 1/2 feet front and 109 ft deep. Fractional lots are 22, 23, 62, 63, 44, 45, 79, 80, 81, 82, 83,  
 84, 85, 86, 87, 88, 89, 90, 91, 92, 93, 94, 95, 96. Streets & lanes. State Street or road is 66 ft wide  
 all streets and lanes run parallel and at right angles with the state road  
 except a road on the East side 4 rods wide running North and South and  
 and a road on the North boundary 16 1/2 ft wide running East and West. The  
 course and bearing of the lots are N. 66° W and N. 24° E.
