

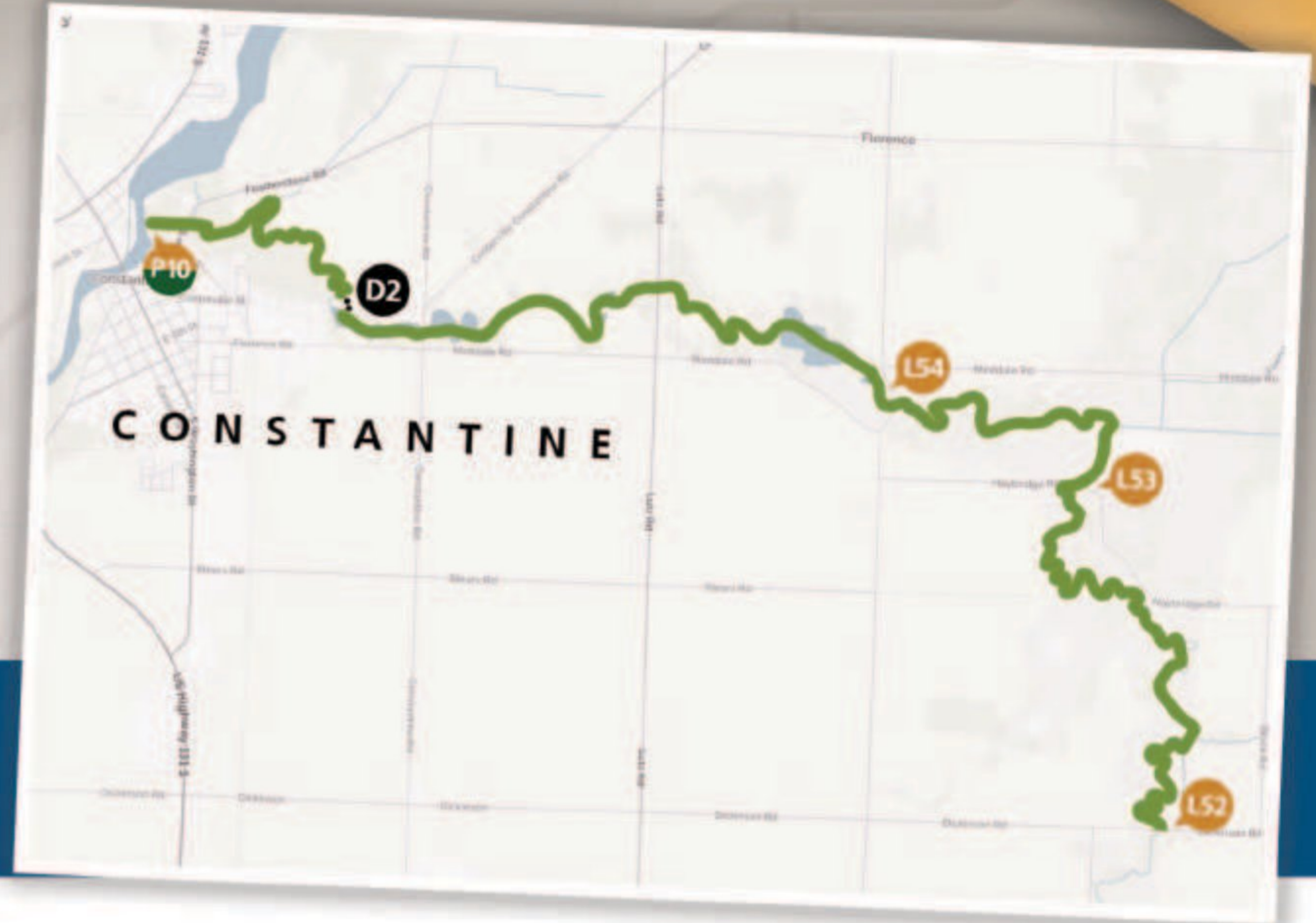

Dickenson Road

Parking for several cars. Easy access to the river down a dirt and grass path.

Haybridge Road

Use Haybridge to either shorten your trip by 1.5 hours or as a scenic, isolated spot to stop for a break. Dirt and grass access path.

Sevison Road

2.5 hours from Dickenson this access point can be used to exit the Fawn River prior to the dam near Constantine. Over 2 hours to Riverview Park.

Riverview Park

After the dam at Ox Paperboard, The Fawn joins the St. Joseph River. Just South you can exit using this park. A great place to picnic/grill, or walk to downtown for restaurants and bars.
